Notes

- 1 The club was established on Nov 4, 1996 as a spin-off from Green River Seniors.
- 2 Officers are elected for a two year term. Elections are held every year at the General Meeting in August. The President and the Tournament Director are elected in even number years while the the remaining officer(s) are elected in odd numbered years. Each office begins September 1 following

the election.

3 Roy Womack resigned the Vice-Presidency mid term and Dennis Renk was appointed by President Axel to succeed him.

4 Due to health issues, Pete Haster resigned and was replaced by Steve Oskorus by President Axel.

5 Because of Dale Pimerton's illness, Dennis Renk was appointed by President Axel to act as Tournament Director until Dale's return. Dennis also continued to serve as Vice-President.

(Unfortunately, Dale passed away and never returned... It should be noted that Dale was the individual most responsible for establishing our club and providing the glue to hold it together in the earlier years.)

6 Steve Oskorus resigned as Secretary/Treasure February 28, 2006 and Lowell Renold was appointed by President Willeford to succeed him.

7 Axel retired due to medical issues. Position eliminated due to reduction in Club's membership. Handicap Chairman's responsibilities reassigned to Tournament Director henceforth titled as Tournament Director and Handicap Chairman.

8 Steve Whitson was killed in a plane crash on June 17, 2009

9 Tom McAllister voted in for a one year term

10 August membership meeting resulted in elimination of VP position by near unanimous vote (one exception)
